Eastern Local School District Bus Route Schedules for 2010-2011

Eastern will announce minor changes in the bus routes for this coming school year. It is our suggestion that parents have students ready early the first day of school in anticipation of bus arrival. Your child's bus driver will probably be the same as last school year. There have been very few changes. Contact the Elementary School at 985-3304 or the High School at 985-3329 or the District Office at 667-6079 for bus driver phone numbers if you wish to contact your driver for further information.

Bus 2 (Mrs. Shelly Caldwell)

Bus 2 will begin on Long Run at approximately 7:00 am then travel on Dewitt's Run, Smith Ridge, Hayman Road to Bald-Knobs Stiversville Road, Bashan Road, Horse Cave Road, Bailey Road, back to Bashan Road (Co. Rd. 28) to Riebel Road and then to Oak Hill Road, from Oak Hill Road to RT 248 on Chester Hill. She will transport students from Chester Hill, and through Chester to Sumner Road (Old Route 7). Students living on Old Route 7 will ride Bus 2. Students on Route 7 from Bahr Road to Eastern will also ride her bus.

Bus 6 (Mrs. Connie Osborne)

Mrs. Osborne will begin as last year West of Alfred on Tucker Road at approximately 7:00 am. She will then travel the following roads: Woods, Guthrie, Karr Road, State Route 681 in the Alfred area, Douglas, Sunny Hollow, Keebaugh – Follrod, Cherry Ridge, Miller, Sumner, Silver Ridge, Myers, Betzing, Partlow and Christy Road. Route 7 to Bahr Road to pick up students on Bahr Road, then proceed to Eastern.

Bus 11 (Mrs. Lesa Sidwell)

Mrs. Sidwell will start her route on Scout Camp Road at approximately 7:05 am. She will travel Sand Ridge, Pine Grove, Vinegar Street, and Whipple Road. Students from Twin Oaks on Flatwoods Road to the intersection of Flatwoods and Pomeroy Pike, and students from the intersection to the Pomeroy Gun Club will ride her bus. Lesa will be responsible for children from Five Points on Route 7 to Eagle Ridge including the Crow Addition. She will transport students from the Baum Addition behind the Karr Construction building. The route will continue on Lake Wood Road, Pomeroy Pike and on to Chester. Students on Route 7 from Chester to the intersection of Summer Road will also ride Mrs. Sidwell's bus.

Bus 12 (Mr. Glenn Easterling)

Mr. Easterling's route will not change. He will begin his route on Eden Ridge Road approximately 7:15 am. The route will then go to State Route 124 to Hocking Port and back to Reedsville. From Reedsville the bus will go to State Route 681 toward Tupper's Plains. Students from Reedsville to the junction of Eden Ridge Road will ride bus 12. Students living in Tupper's Plains who rode Mr. Easterling's bus last school year will also ride this year.

Bus 14 (Mr. Tom Pullins)

Mr. Pullins will begin on Rainbow Ridge at approximately 7:05. He will then proceed to pick up children on Holter Road, Eagle Ridge, and State Route 7 from Eagle Ridge Road to Chester. Some of the students in Chester will ride his bus, especially those living on Scout Camp Road and Allen Street. He will then travel up Chester Hill to Showalter Road. Then from Showalter Road to New Hope Road.

Bus 15 (Mrs. Tammy Adams)

Mrs. Adams will begin her route in Reedsville on State Route 124 at approximately 7:20 am. Her route will include the following roads: Fellowship Drive, Curtis Hollow, State Route 124 to Reedsville, Hudson Hollow Road, Number Nine, Bridle Trail, State Route 681 from Bridle Trail to Tupper's Plains, to the intersection of State Route 7 and students
On RT 7 from Pine Tree Drive to Apple Tree Estates which will include Old Route 7.

Bus 16 (Mr. Lee Swain)

Mr. Swain will begin his route this year on Bigley Ridge at approximately 7:10 am. He will then travel to Long Bottom. His route will then turn to Mount Olive Road. From Long Bottom the bus route will go State Route 248 to the junction of Locust Grove Road. Mr. Swain will then travel to the top of Keno Hill where he will turn around; back to RT 248 then to Taylor Road; from Taylor Road back to Locust Grove Road. He will be responsible for children in Riggs Crest, Bar 30 Road near the Water Company Office and students on Eastern Hill.

Bus 17 (Mrs. Becky Maxson)

Mrs. Maxson will begin at approximately 7:00 am on Licksillet as last year. She will then pickup students on the following roads: Smith-Baker, Osborne Road, Success, Joppa, Coolville, Rye, Rice Run, Limberger Ridge, Pine Tree Drive, and Headley Road.

Bus 18 (Mrs. Carolyn Ritchie)

Mrs. Ritchie will begin her route Owl Hollow Road approximately 7:00 am. She will proceed to State Route 681, Kaylor Road, Main Street Tupper's Plains, State Route 7 through Tupper's Plains to the county line, Arbaugh Addition and Apple Tree Estates.

Bus 22 (Mr. Ed Holter)

Mr. Holter will begin his route on East Shade Road at approximately 7:00 am. He will then travel Skinner Run Road, Cook Road, Wickham Road, Burke Road, Flatwoods Road, Old Forest Road, Rockspring Road, Texas Road and Bailey Road. Mr. Holter will transport students living in the Eastern end of Summer Road from Route 7 to the Parker Farm.

All of the above routes and directions are subject to change, but large scale changes are not likely. Have your children ready early and at the bus stop. If you have any questions you may want to call your bus driver. We thank you for your interest and cooperation in advance and wish you and your child a very happy year.
