Eastern Local Title I Parent Involvement Policy

1. Parents will be notified of the annual Title I meeting.
2. Parents will be informed about all aspects of the Title I program at the annual meeting.
3. Suggestions for ways parents may work with their children at home will be offered throughout the year.
4. Ways to involve parents in the design, operation and evaluation of the program may include surveys, home/school communications, meetings, workshops and progress reports. These ongoing means of consultation will enable parents and staff to work together as partners in the educational process.
5. Parents lacking literacy skills, or whose native language is not English, will have Title I information relayed to them in a different format.
6. Parents will be invited and encouraged to attend fall and spring parent/teacher conferences as well as making classroom visits to discuss the child's progress, placement and methods to help the child succeed in the program.
7. Staff involved in the program will have professional development opportunities designed to train them to work effectively with parents.
8. Comprehensive needs assessment will be conducted as a part of the district's continuous improvement planning process. Student, parent and staff input will be incorporated as a part of this process.
9. Parents and staff may access a variety of materials to utilize with students by consulting with the building principal and/or Title I staff.
10. Parents are encouraged to participate in the volunteer program and receive guidance through the Parent Volunteer Coordinator.
